

ITINERARY

Day 1 : Istanbul - Arrival Day - Istanbul City Tour

Dinner Included Meet at the airport Transfer to and depart for Istanbul City tour. Visit to TOPKAPI PALACE The great palace of the Ottoman sultans from the 15th to the 19th centuries housing an exquisite collection of cyrstal, silver, and Chinese porcelain, robes worn by the sultans and their families, the famous jewels of the Imperial Treasury, miniatures, the Holy Mantle; enshrining relics of the Prophet Mohammed. SULTANAHMET IMPERIAL MOSQUE Across from St. Sophia built in the 16th century by the architect

Mehmet, is known as the BLUE MOSQUE because of its magnificent interior decoration of blue Iznik tiles. HIPPODROME Ancient Hippodrome, the scene of chariot races, with the three monuments; the Obelisk of Theodosius, the bronze Serpentine Column and the Column of Constantine. Lunch break at 13.00 and after the lunch, Murtis Tour will then take you to the Grand Spice Bazaar which is a unique atmosphere with reasonable prices for your shopping on many Exotic Spices and Herbs, Turkish Baklava, Turkish Delights, Turkish Coffee, nuts and fruits, small souvenirs such as Ceramic Handicrafts, Evil Eyes totems, all naturel olive oil, soaps and many other goods in Souvenir Shops and stores.for Shopping and After shopping come back to Hotel. Dinner and overnight in Istanbul.

Day 2: Gallipoli Tour

Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included At 06.30, after an early breakfast, we depart for Gallipoli to visit the battle fields. Two hours later, we will give you 20 minutes for relax in a restaurant area. We arrive Gallipoli around 12.00am and we have lunch break, relax a little bit and then depart for the battle fields. Visit Gabatepe Museum. Start visiting the fields with Ariburnu Cemetery and Anzac Cove because these are the places where the war had started. Then Beach Cemetery, Shrapnel Valley and Plugges Plateau. After the tour, drive to your hotel. Dinner and overnight in Canakkale.

Day 3: Troy Tour - Pergamon - Kusadasi

Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included After breakfast, we depart at 08.30 and drive 30 minutes for to Troy. Visit the famous archeological and mythological site of Troy, home of the Trojan Horse and Helen of Troy. After Troy tour, 3 hour drive to Pergamon. Lunch break around 13.00 and after the lunch, depart for tour of the magnificent acropolis of Pergamon. Its impressive temples and library made it a renowned cultural and political centre at that times. Pergamon is a famous city for its jewelry, stones and silver. On the way, we will visit one of the famous leather production centers of the region, where you will have the opportunity to get a good factory rate. On this guided tour, you will avoid the constant nagging and sometimes bullying that is well known in the markets of Turkey. Enabling you to enjoy the shopping experience whilst gaining the knowledge of the ancient craftsmen. Dinner and overnight in Kusadasi.

Day 4: Kusadasi - Ephesus Tour - Pamukkale

Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included At 08.30, after breakfast, departure from hotel fully guided tour of Ephesus, one of the best preserved ancient sites in the world en - route, visiting the Temple of Artemis, Curetes street, famous Roman baths, Celsus Library and Grand theater. Lunch break around 13.00pm. After the lunch, we will visit a place which continues to perform one of the oldest arts of Turkey; a carpet weaving center. After the shopping, depart for Pamukkale. Dinner and overnight in Pamukkale

Day 5: Pamukkale Tour - Antalya Old City Tour

Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included At 08.30, after breakfast, we depart for Pamukkale. We will visit the calcium terraces of Pamukkale (cotton castle) and the ruins of Hierapolis, then walk around this natural phenomenon and have the option of lying in the waters of the natural springs. After Pamukkale tour, depart for Antalya. Arrive to Antalya and visit to old City (Kaleiçi) Marina, Clock Tower, Hadrian's Gate, Broken Minaret, H?d?rl?k Tower. Dinner and overnight in Antalya.

Day 6: Antalya - Konya - Cappadocia

Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included After breakfast, early in the morning at 08.00, drive to Konya. 2.5 hour later, we have break for coffee and after some rest, drive to Konya for lunch at 13.00 and after the lunch, visit the imposing green - tiled Mausoleum of Mevlana, the mystic founder of the Sufi sect (Whirling Dervishes). After the Konya Mevlana tour, drive to Cappadocia. Arrival to Cappadocia around 18.30 and

check into your hotel. If you wish to join our optional activity of Ballooning for tomorrow, please contact with your guide and register because it will take place early the next morning. Dinner and overnight in Cappadocia.

Day 7: Cappadocia Tour with Underground City and Goreme Open Air Museum

Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included After breakfast, you will be picked up approximately 09.30 that we will drive you to Ozkonak Underground City, one of the best preserved Underground cities in Cappadocia. Then, visit to Uchisar Castle, the highest point of Cappadocia. After Uchisar, you visit Goreme Open Air Museum, the Heart of Cappadocia. Goreme Open Air Museum is famous for frescoes dating to 10th century describing the life of Jesus Christ and monks. Next stop is Cavusinwhich is an abandoned village with old cave Greek houses. After Cavusin, you go to the restaurant in Avanos to have lunch. After lunch, you visit a pottery work shop, to see how to make potteries. Then, you go Pasabagi where you can see three - headed fairy chimneys. After Pasabagi, you visit another workshop to see Cappadocian handwoven carpets and kilims. Next stop is Devrent Valley which is also called Imagination Valley where you can see natural rock formations looking like animals. Then, you head to a wine shop in Urgup for wine tasting. Last stop is Three Beauties, three beautiful fairy chimneys with their hats which are the symbol of Cappadocia. This tour will end approximately at 18.00 and you will be returned back to your hotel. Dinner and overnight in Cappadocia.

Day 8: Cappadocia - Ankara

Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included Depart for Ankara, after the breakfast, the capital of Turkey and the country's second largest city after Istanbul. Lunch at local restaurant then visit the Anatolia Civilization Museum, an exceptional museum with its unique collection, has Anatolian archaeological artefacts and artefacts from the Palaeolithic Age to the present. Visit to modern Turkey's founder's (Mustafa Kemal ATATURK) final resting place called An?tkabir, the mausoleum.On the way to hotel, panoramic view of Ankara. Dinner and overnight in Ankara.

Day 9: Ankara - Bosphorus Cruise and Istanbul - Airport/End of the Tour

Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included After the breakfast, we depart for Istanbul.We will take a Cruise on the Bosphorus. An unforgettable excursion starts between two continents, Europe and Asia. The cruise will take you along the Bosphorus, past the Europeans style palaces of the great Ottomans, Dolmabahce and Beylerbeyi, as well as the beautiful wooden kiosks of the 19th century, mansions and modern villas, which form the elegant sections of the city.
