


Full Itinerary & Trip Details

4 Day Fethiye To Olympos Cabin Cruise

The Fethiye to Olympos Blue Cruise that takes 4 days and 3 nights to cruise down to Olympos, is the most popular route along the Turquoise Coastline*. Travelling on a Turkish gulet, this blue cruise has something for everyone. From the ancient cities and sights to crystal clear waters for swimming and snorkeling. You depart Fethiye to cruise on for Butterfly Valley where you can take the time to hike in the valley or just enjoy the vivid blue ocean for your first swim. You then cruise past Europe's most photographed beach, Oludeniz, anchoring on the back of the Blue Lagoon. That afternoon you anchor at St Nicholas Island, where you can explore the ruins before catching the sunset. Kas and the Kekova region will be explored over the next few days. You will be taken past the famous Sunken City of Kekova, have time to go shopping in Kas and visit the ruins of Simena Castle. Throughout your blue cruise you will be offered the chance to undertake some optional activities of paragliding and diving, you will get the chance to relax and swim in some stunning bays, whilst the whole time enjoying a plentiful of Turkish dishes and hospitality. When you board your Blue Cruise, you will be cruising along on a standard Turkish gulet. These gulets are now to a very high standard and all the cabins come with private ensuite bathroom. The gulet will be equipped with sunbeds, shaded area and some water toys are usually on board with snorkeling gear. The cabin options on the gulet could be twin, double or triple depending on the yacht layout. You will depart your gulet cruise in Ucagiz Village Harbor where you will then be transferred to Olympos as part of your Blue Cruise adventure. Fethiye to Olympos gulet cruise is the most popular gulet cruise in Turkey because of the variety of highlight destination of sites which this coastline includes. The coastline keep relics from the ancient Lycians, Romans, Ottoman and Greeks.Lycia in Turkey is an ancient region in Turkey famous for the Lycian Way which is a hiking track that stretches for 500 miles from Oludeniz to Antalya. Lycia derives from ancient Greece and was once a thriving civilization of the Mediterranean. There are many extraordinary beaches that are scattered along this coastal hiking route. One such beach is Patara beach in Lycia which is a highlight of the cruise.

ITINERARY

Day 1: Fethiye to St Nicholas Island

Lunch and Dinner Included Today you will begin your cruise with check-in at the TravelShopTurkey office at the Fethiye harbour at 09:00 am, here you will be given information before boarding the gulet where you will be given a brief about your cruise. We will depart Fethiye harbour and cruise to Butterfly Valley for swimming, lunch and an optional hike up to the waterfall. Butterfly Valley is known to be the home to over 136 different types of butterflies and moths, however in the summer months difficult to spot. Afterwards, we

will visit Oludeniz beach, Europe's most photographed beach and one of the best sites in the world to paraglide. Tonight we will anchor at St. Nicholas Island, we arrive in time to walk up through the island's ruins and witness the amazing sunset.

Day 2: St Nicholas Island to Kas

Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included Today we cruise to Kalkan (Aquarium Bay) for breakfast and swimming. This is a fantastic spot to put on the goggles, do some snorkelling and make the most of the crystal clear waters. We will then cruise onto Kas, a small fishing village with a charming little harbour, to enjoy lunch on the boat. We will spend the night in one of the secluded bays between Kas and Kekova.

Day 3: Kas to Gokkaya Bay

Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included Today after breakfast we will cruise to the area of Kekova. First, on the list, we will discover the Sunken City, an ancient town dating back 2000 years to the Lycian period and destroyed by an earthquake. We will cruise over this protected World Heritage site, however, no swimming, diving or snorkelling is allowed in this area. We will then cross to Simena Castle where you can walk to the top and witness a magical view over the bay, taking in the underwater Lycian Tombs and the Sunken City. Overnight in Gokkaya Bay.

Day 4: Gokkaya Bay to Olympos

Breakfast and Lunch Included On your last day, you can enjoy a lazy start, resting off any sore heads from partying until the wee hours. After breakfast, you will head to Ucagiz Village Harbour. Lunch is not included on the last day. There will then be a free transfer to the treehouse of your choice in Olympos (2-hour drive). Or, if you're planning to travel onto other locations, you'll be dropped off at Demre bus station (10-minute drive) where you can catch a local bus. Buses to Antalya depart every 30 minutes, buses to Kas or Fethiye depart every hour and no need to (can't) book pre-book these buses.
