ITINERARY

Day 1 : Welcome Dubrovnik

Dinner Included Welcome to Croatia! Today you will begin your cruise of the Adriatic along the Croatian coast. The first night will be spent on in the harbour of Dubrovnik, this is the perfect time to get to know your fellow passengers, your Captain and your crew. Check-in time is 17:00, with dinner and welcome speeches for 18:00. If you arrive in Dubrovnik early and wish to experience the wonders of the city, you are welcome to visit the boat and leave your luggage on board ready for you. While here in Dubrovnik you have some

optional excursions, you can enjoy. Buggy safari – Drive a small off-road vehicle up Mount Srd and view the Old City below and the Islands in the Distance. Cable Car Ride – Take a cable car to the top of Mount Srd to walk around the viewing point where you can view the city below. Game of Thrones Tour – Dubrovnik is home to many sets for the world-famous HBO Tv show ‘Game of Thrones’, take a tour of these different sets in the historic city. Shuttle Boat – Take a shuttle boat to Lokrum Island from the Old City.

Day 2 : Dubrovnik to Korcula

Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included Today you will set sail from Dubrovnik harbour heading to the island of Korcula. This Adriatic island is said to have been the birthplace of the famous writer Marco Polo. The island also shares its name with the Old city and harbour, Korcula, and offers an amazing time wandering around and exploring. As the Evening rolls around the narrow streets open up with their bars and begin a night of partying in popular places such as Deja Vu Bar.

Day 3 : Korcula to Hvar Island

Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included Today you will depart from Korcula Island heading to Hvar Island. You will spend the morning sailing arriving at Hvar small harbour after lunch, due to port restrictions you will make port in the late afternoon or early evening. To reach the town earlier you can take a water taxi earlier. Please be aware in peak season the docking location may change. Famous for its nightlife Korcula offers a full evening and night filled with entertainment, this begins with a fantastic meal and watching the sunset. As the night comes round many make their way to a small island to a unique club called Carpe Diem, known as ‘club on the island’. Note: Hvar’s towns port is small, during peak season the harbour can get busy which can lead the harbour authority to order the boat to dock at another place such as Stari Grad about 35 minutes by bus to Hvar town.

Day 4 : Hvar Island to Split

Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included Today you will begin your day with a swim stop at one of the Pakleni islands that are found Set out from Hvar Island cruise the turquoise waters, your first stop of the day is at one of the Pakleni islands. After spending time enjoying the beautiful wares you will continue on to Split, you will arrive in the afternoon allowing time to explore this beautiful city. Home to the Diocletian’s Palace a living ancient palace that acts as the modern city centre. Optional: Take an afternoon adventure by going River Rafting at Omis along the River Cetina.

Day 5 : Split to Makarska

Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included Wake up to the view of the stunning city Split, today you get the chance to spend your morning exploring the city. Visit some of the historical destinations or visit the different sets that can be found all across Croatia. You will depart Split at 13:00, as you cruise to Makarska you will enjoy time swimming at one of the beautiful blue bays. You will arrive and dock at Makarska in the late afternoon, this will let you spend some time wandering the stunning place before heading to the promenade to enjoy a meal in one of the pizzerias, restaurants, and cafes. After dinner why not dance the night away in the locally famous ‘Rave in a Cave’ called Club Deep.

Day 6 : Makarska to Mljet

Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included Departing early, the captain will cruise to the Mljet Island crossing heading to the island of the same name. spend the morning floating on the breathtaking turquoise waters to dock after lunch at one of Mljet’s main towns, either Polace or Pomena. The afternoon here is your own, you can; relax in the town, enjoy the sun aboard your boat, or explore the island’s nature park and its lakes. Optional: While on Mljet you can explore the visit the Nature park here, which is a small cost for entry.

Additionally, a popular way to traverse the park to rent a bicycle to peddle along the tracks. Optional: Enjoy a night of fresh food prepared by your Captain and Crew.

Day 7 : Mljet to Dubrovnik

Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included Today you will begin by enjoying a relaxing time visiting the bays around Mljet Island. Swim, relax and work on your tan before heading through the archipelago of Elaphite Islands. Early afternoon will see you arrive in Dubrovnik with plenty of time to enjoy the different excursions or simply walk around the city and enjoy the ancient architecture that it offers. Along with stunning architecture, the old city is home to a fantastic selection of restaurants and bars nestled within the old streets. While here you can take part in some optional Excursions Optional: Zipline over a local beach near the city of Dubrovnik. Optional: Take a tour of the sets from the hit TV HBO show 'Game of Thrones'. Throughout Dubrovnik, you can see key points of the story of the show among the ancient architecture. Optional: If your interests are in the historic then take the Dubrovnik historic walking tour that will show you the best of the cities history.

Day 8 : Dubrovnik

Breakfast Included Today is your final morning on the boat, checkout is at 10:00; However, this does not mean that this is the end of your adventure. Take your free time exploring the city or take outside of the city. This is your chance to enjoy these Optional tours that you may have missed your first day.
