

ITINERARY

Day 1: Dikili Cruise Excursions - Pergamon And Asklepion Tour

Upon your arrival to Dikili Cruise Port, our official tour guide meets you at harbor and drive to Pergamum Acropolis to see the steepest theater of the ancient world, the Temple of Trajan, and then visit the Asklepion, the ancient hospital with our new brand tour transportation vehicle.

Pergamum Acropolis - The finest altar (shrine) ever built is accepted as the Zeus Altar in Pergamum in 180

BC. Most parts of the Zeus Altar are now in the Berlin Pergamum Museum. The altar was in the Acropolis, which is some 300 meters above the modern city of Bergama. The ancient theater in the Acropolis is the steepest Hellenistic Theater in the world. The theater has 80 rows with over 10.000 spectator capacity. The theater lies on the hill in the Acropolis overlooking the modern city of Bergama and Gediz Valley. Asklepion - Asclepieum, a sanctuary and a healing center built for Asclepieum, the God of healing, was the first hospital in the world and was built in the 4th century BC. This large complex became an official center in the 3rd century BC and in the 2nd century Hadrian further developed the complex. Close to the complex in Pergamum, Serapeum (Temple of Serapis-Turkish name Kizil Avlu), was built in the 2nd century AD during the king of Hadrian and was dedicated to the Gods of Egypt. Because of the red bricks used in the construction, the building is also called the Red Court.

After the tour if you would like to do some cheap shopping just tell your guide and they will happily arrange this for you. Then drive back to your cruise. We hope your tour was a memorable one and we would like to see you in the future in one of our tours again. Thanks for choosing us.
