

Welcome to our Special Golf Package! Klassis Golf Hotel is situated right on the golf course, with beautiful views and decent facilities. Open all year round, the hotel also features 2 outdoor pools, 1 indoor pool, a spa and its own Equestrian Centre. Klassis Golf and Country Club, Istanbul, is an 18 hole, 73 par Championship Golf Course designed by one of the world's top players; Tony Jacklin. The course is 6072 meters in length and is considered a tough course, particularly with its location in a rough landscape. The beautifully kept Klassis Golf Course meets European standards, and has hosted many international tournaments, including the PGA European Challenge Tour, PGA Seniors Tour and European Club Cup Trophy. The course has four par 3, nine par 4 and five par 5 holes. Klassis features two lakes spread over 35,184 sqm area in total. There is also a 9-hole Academy course, par 27 and 907 meters long. Also featured is a 225 meter driving range, 9 hole putting green, and a great on site pro shop.

Visit to TOPKAPI PALACE The great palace of the Ottoman sultans from the 15th to the 19th centuries housing an exquisite collection of cyrstal, silver, and Chinese porcelain, robes worn by the sultans and their families, the famous jewels of the Imperial Treasury, miniatures, the Holy Mantle; enshrining relics of the Prophet Mohammed. SULTANAHMET IMPERIAL MOSQUE Across from St. Sophia built in the 16th century by the architect Mehmet, is known as the BLUE MOSQUE because of its magnificent interior decoration of blue Iznik tiles. HIPPODROME Ancient Hippodrome, the scene of chariot races, with the three monuments; the Obelisk of Theodosius, the bronze Serpentine Column and the Column of Constantine. Lunch break at 13:00pm after the lunch we will then take you to the GRAND SPICE BAZAAR. after visit, Transfer back to your hotel. Overnight in Istanbul.

Please Note: Hagia Sophia closed on Mondays, Topkapi Closed on Tuesdays Grand Bazaar closed on Sundays.
