

#### Day 1: DAILY IASOS AND EUROMOS TOUR FROM CESME

Pick up from your hotel and depart to Iasos Ancient City. which was founded by Argos. We see and receive information from the remains of the Agora, the Temple of Artemis, the Temple of Zeus Megistos, and the Theater. In Iasos, we watch the purple colored marble veins with interest. We realize that this beautiful marble is used in abundance in urban architecture.

One of the most interesting places we will see on this trip is the old Fish Market, which was turned into a bathhouse during the Mente?e Sons Period. Essentially, Iasos is one of the most important fish markets of antiquity.

After completing our Iasos trip, we go to the little-known Euromos antique city, near Ayakli Village. We see the Zeus Lepsynos Temple, one of the best-kept temples in Anatolia. Although the temple built in ancient times was destroyed, M.S. It was rebuilt in the 2nd century BC during the Roman Imperial period. We tour Euromos on the footsteps of columns, votive inscriptions, physicist Menekrates and his daughter Tryphania. The tour program in this beautiful geography ends in the evening and our return journey to Cesme hotel.
