

ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrival Day

Welcome to Turkey, today is your arrival day. After arriving at Istanbul International Airport directly proceed to domestic departures for your flight to Igdir. Meet at Igdir airport and transfer to your hotel. You will be given your room key and the rest of the day is yours to explore Antalya. Overnight in Igdir.

Day 2: Igdir Historical Tour

Breakfast Included

We will pick you up from the hotel in the morning. We will visit today:

Igd?r is the city that is the center of the province of I?d?r. Turkey's Erzurum in Eastern Anatolia Region - is located in the department of Kars. The city center consists of 3 towns and 49 villages.

Karakale Ruin: It is located on the border of Armenia, where I?d?r plain is located, among the Urartians, which is suitable for defense. Selecting whether the region is the oldest settlement castle

Meteor (Meteor) Pit: This pit in Korhan Plateau is a big pit formed in 1892 with the fall of a meteorite. It ranks second after Barringer Crater in Arizona in terms of size and depth in the world. Its width is 35 meters and its depth is about 60 meters. It is also possible to come across many processed stones around the pit. It is notable for its rich nature scenery and floral richness.

Seljuk (Harmandoven) Caravanserai: Caravanserai, located on Asmakoyu road, is one of the most beautiful works of 12th century Seljuk stone processing. It was taken under protection in 1986. However, it is still in ruins.

Ahura Ruins: Ahura is located in Yakup Valley on the northern slopes of Büyük A?r? Mountain. The ruin at 1,750 meters, BC. It is a settlement established in the 2nd century during the Artaxiya Kingdom.

Tuzluca Salt Caves: Turkey has a place in the 100-year capacity to meet the needs salt. It is known that the air in the tunnels in this 55-acre salt-covered land is good for the respiratory tract. It has the capacity to produce 60 tons of salt per day.

Ram Headed Tombs: The ram-headed graves found in all the old cemeteries in the I?d?r plain are from the Karakoyunlular period, which left a permanent civilization trail in I?d?r. According to Karakoyunlu, these gravestones were erected in the graves of brave and heroic people and young people who died at a young age. This tradition came to Karakoyunlular from Central Asian Turkish Culture.

Martyr Turks Monument and Museum: It symbolizes the Armenian attacks in the region between 1915-1920 and related documents are kept. Around 4,000 visitors visit the museum every month. 350 m² closed museum consists of 2 pools and 5 swords of 36 m height. It is built as a green area and a park. Turkey's highest monument

After the tour, transfer back to your hotel. Overnight in Igdir.

Day 3: Turkish Bath In Igdir Tour

Breakfast Included

Meet with your tour guide at the hotel lobby in the determined time. The Turkish bath is a place, where physical and spiritual cleaning takes place and is hundreds of years old. In 1741 Istanbul built its first public bath house in Sultan Mehmet. Natural lighting and izonic colored tiles create a relaxing atmosphere. When entering to Turkish bath, you leave all the hastiness of daily life outside, you exchange your clothes for a waistcloth and adorn the traditional clogs. Inside temperature reach up to 50 degrees Celcius under the central dome of the building. This heat and humidite opens the pores of body and extracts the fatty anoils of the body in preparation for your scrub down and a massage by the attendant. After a gentle soap massage, you leave the bath place with towels and pass to resting room. Here, tea is offered to you. You leave the Turkish Bath renewed, beautiful, and refreshed. Transfer back to your hotel. Thank you for choosing us and we hope you have a memorable time in Turkey. We look forward to seeing you in the future on another adventure with us. After the tour, transfer back to your hotel. Overnight in Igdir.

Day 4: Igdir Cooking Lesson & Shopping Tour

Breakfast and Lunch Included

After breakfast, we take our guests from the hotel and depart to a local restaurant for your professional cooking lesson. You participate in your first Turkish cooking lesson:

I?d?r is like a mirror that reflects the traditions of Turkish culture. It also distinguishes itself with its local flavors. Pastry dishes are a type of food that the region frequently consumes. In this article, we wanted to explain the local dishes of I?d?r and the taste of the city.

Katik soup is one of the most popular flavors of the region. It has a sour taste. Its main ingredient consists of yogurt and lepe. Fresh village butter is ready for presentation with its spicy seasonings.

A useful meal prepared with kelecosh bulgur, prunes, lepe, curd cheese and onion, which takes its place in the tables as a kind of soup in I?d?r. Ayranashi is our delicious soup, one of the cornerstones of Turkish cuisine. It is a refreshing alternative in Igd?r's hot summer months, because it is both satisfying and nutritious. We recommend you to taste this useful taste prepared from chickpeas, wheat and yogurt. Zibilli pilaf, which is a rich rice, has the feature of being a hearty main dish. An aromatic taste is added with spice varieties. Katlet, which is a meal unique to Igd?r region, has been prepared inspired by the natural flavors of the Caucasian. Minced meat is the main ingredient of the dish. It is among the local dishes that you must try in Igd?r. In Igd?r province, where chicken meat is very popular, this juicy dish made with baguettes is an unsatisfying taste. Chicken shorba, which includes many nutritious foods such as potatoes, onions, boiled chickpeas, is served as a main dish both at home and in restaurants. Bozbash, one of the local tastes of I?d?r, is a traditional dish prepared with ingredients such as lamb's pearl, tail oil and chickpeas. The nutritionalness and taste of this dish, which is cooked and served in its own special bowl in restaurants, is appreciated. You can also order restaurants and restaurants in the center of Igd?r. Omach halva, which is a dessert made frequently in Igd?r in the winter months, is a traditional dessert made in the city for many years. Although it is not different from flour halva for those who see it for the first time, there are various differences in the way this halva is made. When adding materials, it is ensured to be blended by rubbing method. The fact that the flour has turned into wet sand after the rubbing process is completed is proof of success. Then you need to go to the cooking stage.

The softest of the jam is eggplant jam. Eggplant jam, which has a different flavor compared to other jam varieties, has become one of the symbols of I?d?r cuisine. It is generally consumed at breakfasts. It is a

nutritious snack.

After lunch you will depart to city center for free time and shopping before returning to your hotel. After the tour drop back to your hotel. Overnight in Igdir.

Day 5: Igdir Cultural Tour

Breakfast Included

We will pick you up from the hotel in the morning. We will visit today:

Koroglu Castle: According to the legend, the famous Koroglu was used as a watchtower for this castle. It is even reported that the Aras River in the vicinity is protected from enemies thanks to this watchtower.

Hal?k?shlak, located in Tuzluca district between Armenia and Igd?r, is one of the main stops of picnic lovers!

You can have a pleasant and beautiful day in this promenade area, which carries snapshots from both communities.

Gokdekli Cupola, located in the district of December, was built in the name of Hac? Ibrahim Gokdek, which has a very respectable place in the town. There are tombs of three people in Gokdekli Cupola, which is very valuable for the people of the region. Although it remains a mystery to whom the tombs belong, the building is known to be quite old

Urartu Hills, located in the Melekli region, appeared during the excavations made in 1913.

Although belonging to the Urartu, many items such as ornaments, pistols and seals belonging to the chipped stone age were found in these excavations. These hills have the most beautiful views of the region, both for those interested in mountain bikes and for horseback riding.

Located in Melekli region, Melekli Tufan Ali Open Air Museum is a building from Aras Turks. You can easily see the historical coaches museum from the Museum, which is also very close to the city center of Igd?r. It is Coshkun Oluz, one of the leading in the region, that ensures that the ruins in the region are taken under care and turned into a museum.

Shahmeran Hill and Cave, located in Melekli district, 5 km from the city center, have been the subject of various stories and fairy tales. The story told by the local people is quite interesting. In this rather large endless cave, King Shahmeran, the most magnificent and most fearful of snakes, falls in love with a person in this region. When he realizes that his love is mutual, the relationship between Shahmeran and his lover continues in this cave. They interact with each other and meet secretly. Although what remains at the end of the story remains a mystery, of course, the reality of this story remains a mystery. Many years later, many belongings of chipped stone age were found in this large cave. There are even traces of these ruins in the homes of people living in the region.

After the tour, transfer back to your hotel. Overnight in Igdir.

Day 6: Igdir to Istanbul - End of Tour
