Day 1 : DAILY EPHEBUS SIRINCE TOUR FROM ISTANBUL

Meet with your tour guide at the hotel lobby in the morning. We will take you to Istanbul or Sabiha Gokcen Airport and it takes about 45 Minutes. Upon arrival Izmir Airport, We will pick you up from airport and we will start to our tour. Visit the ancient city of Ephesus including the Basilica of St. John. We tour the spectacular ruins where excavations still continue in this once great and important city, which was founded in the 10th century BC. Walk through history along marble streets lined with wonderful public buildings, among them the Baths of Scholastica, the Library of Celsus, the Temple of Hadrian and the Theatre. The Temple of Diana of the Ephesians, another of the seven wonders of the ancient world, was built in this city. We visit the Basilica of St. John. Visit The House of Virgin Mary. After the tour, transfer back Izmir Airport and pick you up from Istanbul Airport to drop you off your hotel in Istanbul.
