

Day 1: Daily Harran City Tour

Pick up from your hotel in the morning and then depart to Daily Harran Tour. After breakfast, we are picked up from our hotel and set out to start our tour. In the Mesopotamian culture on the Silk Road, we reach our Harran district, which has the belief of Sin, the goddess of the moon, and which means crossing roads. The Harran mound, which is located at the height of 22 meters in the middle of Harran City, the mosque, whose dome was built by the Umayyad caliph Mervan, is wooden, the First Islamic Madrasah (Harran University), the Inner Castle, the Historical Walls in the courtyard. and we visit the houses with conical domes. Then, Turkey's largest irrigation project, the basalt material in the body of an old volcanic mountains in 1919 meters altitude we reach the outskirts of Montenegro brought the Ataturk Dam. through the observation terrace we can see the monument made for a relatively short time completed Turkey's medar boast that workers who lost their lives during the construction of the dam listening by our guide in one of these unique structures such as 8 years. After end of the tour return to hotel.
